Paper Presentation Guidelines



Guidelines

- ❖ The subject of each technical presentation is left entirely to the individual student. Presentations often focus on recent advances in some branch of chemical engineering, original research, or plant design. Participation in the Regional Student Technical Presentation Competition (STPC) offers valuable, real-world experience for students.
- ❖ Each entry must be an undergraduate student and a member of one of the participating student chapters. Others may present, but cannot be considered for the top prize.
- ❖ There is no limit on the number of technical presentations submitted for presentation by a participating student chapter.
- ❖ Co-authorship of technical presentations is permitted. However, only one person shall make the presentation at the Regional STPC, and this person must have been substantially involved in the project or subject of the technical presentation.
- ❖ A panel of three judges will judge STPC presentations. The decision of these judges will be final.
- ❖ The winner of the competition shall receive a cash award of \$200 from AIChE and will be invited to present at the Annual Student Conference STPC.
- ❖ The schedule and abstracts will be published on the conference website.
- ❖ A/V and setup room will be provided.
- ❖ The Second-Place holder will receive a cash award of \$100 from AIChE.
- ❖ The Third-Place holder will receive a cash award of \$50 from AIChE.

- ❖ 25 minutes will be given for each paper competition presentation (15 minutes for presentation, 5 minutes for Q&A and 5 minutes for judges to debrief).
 - ❖ Only one Technical Presentation from each AIChE SRC shall be presented at the Annual Student Conference STPC.
 - ❖ In case of a tie, one Student Technical Presentation will be nominated by the judges for presentation during the Annual Student Conference STPC.
